## INTERLIBRARY LOAN SERVICES

Interlibrary loan services are available to Shelton State students and faculty through the library. Forms for requests are available at the circulation desk and should be filled out with the help of a librarian.

Certain costs are sometimes involved in interlibrary loan; magazine articles, for example, are usually duplicated and borrowers must pay duplication costs. Students and faculty members who make interlibrary loan requests are responsible for all costs except mailing.

Requests are made for specific titles; general subject searches are not made through interlibrary loan. Borrowers should also be aware that searches may take as long as six-eight weeks. Usually books with recent publication dates are not available for interlibrary loan.

Through Shelton's cooperative agreements with the University of Alabama, interlibrary loan requests may be made directly through ILL office on the first floor of the UA main library. Materials will be mailed to Shelton and picked up in the library.
